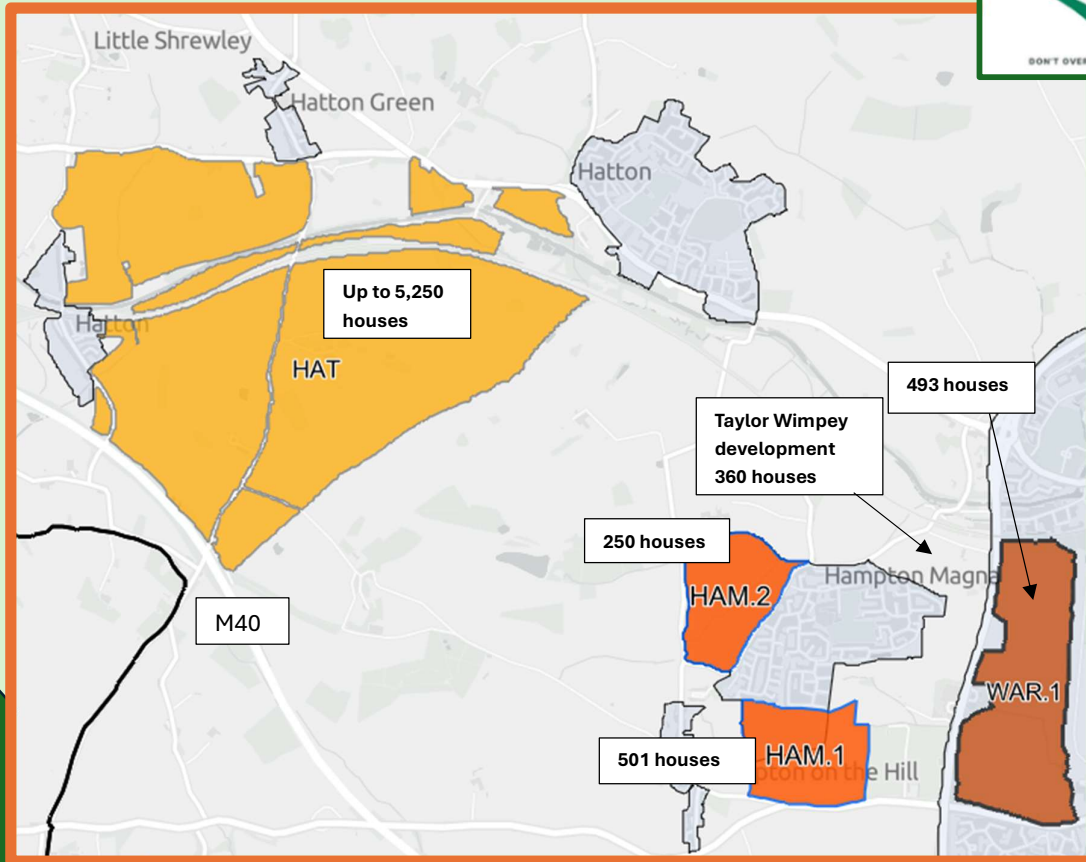


Hatton New Town
